Read this manual before operating your Orbic TAB8 4G and keep it for future reference.

Getting Started

This guide helps you learn about your Orbic TAB8 4G, assembly procedures, and how to get started using your Orbic TAB8 4G.



Keys	Description
Front Camera	To take pictures and videos of yourself
Volume Button	To adjust the volume of your Orbic TAB8 4G's sound and audio playback
SIM/microSD Card Slot	To insert SIM/microSD card

Assemble Orbic TAB8 4G


Before using the Orbic TAB8 4G, you must install the SIM card, memory card, and charge the battery.

Your Orbic TAB8 4G uses a nano SIM card. The SIM card may come preinstalled or you can use your old SIM card.

Installing a microSD Card/SIM Card

To install a SIM card or a microSD, power off the Orbic TAB8 4G and follow the below steps:

- 1. Insert the SIM pin tool into the SIM pinhole on the tray to open the tray.
- 2. Insert the SIM and/or microSD card with the gold contacts facing down and close the tray.




Charging the Battery

Before using your Orbic TAB8 4G, Orbic recommends that you fully charge the battery (100%).

Warning! Use only approved charging devices and batteries. Using other accessories may void your warranty and may damage your Orbic TAB8 4G.

- 1. Plug the USB cable into the USB power adapter.
- 2. Plug the power adapter into a standard outlet.
- 3. Plug the other end of the USB cable into the Orbic TAB8 4G's USB port as shown.



NOTE:

- Charge your Orbic TAB8 4G's battery with the Orbic TAB8 4G turned OFF to maximise efficiency.
- Over time, battery life decreases steadily.
- Do not charge the battery for longer than eight hours.

Set Up Your Orbic TAB8 4G

Turn Your Orbic TAB8 4G ON/OFF

The instructions below explain how to turn your Orbic TAB8 4G ON or OFF.

To Turn the Orbic TAB8 4G ON

Press and hold the **Power/Lock** key until the Orbic TAB8 4G turns ON.

NOTE: The first time you use your Orbic TAB8 4G, you'll need to set it up.

To Turn the Orbic TAB8 4G OFF

- 1. If the display is OFF, press the **Power/Lock** to turn it back on.
- 2. Press and hold the **Power/Lock** for a few seconds.
- 3. When the Orbic TAB8 4G options menu appears, tap **Power OFF**.
- 4. Tap **OK**.

Initial Setup

The first time you turn your Orbic TAB8 4G ON (or after a reset to factory settings), the on-screen prompts guide you through the basics of setting up your Orbic TAB8 4G.

Follow the prompts to choose a default language, set up accounts, choose location services, and much more.

Secure Your Orbic TAB8 4G

You can use your Orbic TAB8 4G's screen lock features to secure your Orbic TAB8 4G.

- To lock the Orbic TAB8 4G, press the **Power** key.
- To unlock the Orbic TAB8 4G, press the **Power** key and swipe up to unlock.

Touchscreen Gestures

Тар	You can select the on-screen items such as application icons or settings buttons by touching them with your finger.
Tap and Hold	Touch and hold your finger over the item to open its options.
Swipe or Slide	Drag your finger horizontally or vertically across the screen.
Drag	Tap and hold your finger before you begin to drag and hold your finger down until the item reaches your desired location.
Flick	Swiping the screen is similar to flicking, but you need to swipe it with lighter and quicker strokes instead. Finger gestures are always vertical. For example, flicking through contacts or messages.
Rotate	You can change the orientation of most screens from portrait to landscape simply by turning the Orbic TAB8 4G sideways. Turning the Orbic TAB8 4G sideways will bring up a larger on-screen keyboard.

Know Your Orbic TAB8 4G

Home Screen

The Home screen serves as the start of your experience.



The Home screen is displayed when the Orbic TAB8 4G is in idle mode.

The Home screen allows you to add shortcuts, folders, and widgets to your favorite apps to be easily accessible.

To access the Home screen

Press Home key

 to return to the center of the home screen.

Customising the Home Screen

You can customise the Home screens and the display wallpaper.

Moving an Item on the Home Screen

- 1. Open the Home screen you want to customise.
- 2. Tap and hold the item you want to move until a box appears around it.
- 3. Drag the item to a new location on your Home screen.
- 4. Release your finger at the location where you want the item.

NOTE: To add shortcuts to a Home screen, swipe up from your app list to reveal all your applications. Next, find the app you wish to add, tap and hold on the item, and drag it onto the Home screen.

Removing an Item from the Home Screen

- 1. From the Home screen, tap and hold an item until a box appears around it.
- 2. Drag the item to **X Remove** and release it.

Changing the Wallpaper of the Home Screen

- 1. From the Home screen, tap and hold any empty area on the Home screen for a few seconds.
- 2. Tap **Wallpapers**. Choose a photo from your camera gallery or memory card.
- 3. Tap Set Wallpaper.

Widgets

Widgets are extensions for applications that appear on the Home screen. Widgets include links to a specific contact, Internet bookmarks, Gmail and email accounts, and many more.

Add a Widget to a Home Screen

- Touch and hold any empty area on the Home screen > select Widgets.
- 2. Touch and hold the required widget, drag it to the Home screen and release it.

Remove a Widget

- 1. From the Home screen, touch and hold the widget you want to remove.
- 2. Drag the widget to **X Remove** and release it.

NOTE: By removing a widget, you are not deleting it but rather removing it from the Home screen.

App Shortcuts

You can add a shortcut to the Home screen.

Adding an App Shortcut

- 1. Touch and hold any preloaded or downloaded app on the Home screen.
- 2. Drag the app to the screen and release it.

Removing the Shortcut

- 1. Touch and hold the app shortcut you want to remove from the Home screen.
- 2. Drag the app shortcut to **X Remove** and release it.

Folders

Use folders to organise items on your Home screen.

Creating/Removing a Folder

- 1. Drag one application over another to create a folder.
- 2. You can name a folder and drag other applications into it.
- 3. You can move folders in the same way that you move applications.
- 4. To remove a folder, touch and hold the folder that you want to remove, drag the folder to **X Remove** and release it.

Status Bar

The Status Bar at the top of the home screen provides Orbic TAB8 4G information (such as network status, battery charge, and time) on the right side and notification alerts on the left.



Notification Panel

Notification icons on the Status Bar display calendar events, Orbic TAB8 4G status, and much more.

Viewing and Responding to Notifications

1. Tap and hold the Status bar, and slide your finger downward to open the Notifications panel.



- 2. If you have multiple notifications, you may have to scroll through them all.
- 3. Tap the desired notification to respond.
- 4. To close the notification panel, drag the bottom bar of the panel or tap **Back**.

Using the On-screen Keyboard

Type your text input using the on-board keyboard. The keyboard opens automatically in some applications. For others, tap anywhere in a text field to launch the keyboard.

- 1. Tap each letter on the on-screen keypad.
- 2. Tap and hold a letter for additional key options (not all keys have additional options). Additional key options include numbers and letters with accent marks. If options are available, you will see a box with all the options shown. Slide your finger to select the character you want.
- 3. You may continue until the word is complete.



Toolbar

The toolbar provides quick access to features of the keyboard.

From the keyboard, tap ••• **Expand toolbar** for the following options:

- Emojis: Insert an emoji.
- Stickers: Add illustrated stickers.
- GIFs: Add animated GIFs.
- Voice input: Use Google Voice[™] typing.
- Settings: Access keyboard settings.
- **Search**: Locate specific words or phrases in your conversations.
- **Translate**: Type words or sentences in the keyboard to translate them into another language.
- **Text editing**: Use an editing panel to help pinpoint text that you want to cut, copy, and paste.
- Modes: Select a keyboard layout.
- **Keyboard size**: Adjust the height and width of the keyboard.

NOTE: You can select input methods when typing in the notification panel.

Adding/Editing/Deleting Words in the User Dictionary

The predictive text dictionary may require the addition of a word, for example, a name or a technical term.

If you want to add a word to your User Dictionary while typing,

 Double-tap it to highlight > tap and hold the word, and select Add to dictionary.

If you want to add a word manually

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > tap the Settings 2.
- 2. Scroll down and tap the System.
- 3. Tap Language & input.
- 4. Tap **Personal Dictionary** and tap the **plus sign**.
- 5. Type the word > tap \rightarrow Enter on the keyboard.

Editing/Deleting a Word

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > tap the Settings 8.
- 2. Scroll down and Tap the **System**.
- 3. Tap Language & input > Advanced.
- 4. Tap **Personal Dictionary** > tap the word to delete or edit.
- 5. Tap 🔟 to delete the word.

Editing Text

You can select, copy or cut the text you've entered, then paste it in another text field within the user interface.

NOTE: Some applications may offer different text editing methods.

Select the Text

- 1. Tap the text field.
- 2. Move the cursor to the beginning or end of the desired text by tapping in the location you want the cursor.
- 3. Tap and hold the text field.
- 4. Tap **Select word** in the pop-up menu or tap **Select all** to select all the text in the text field.
- 5. Drag your finger to move the text cursor to the letter within the text that you want to select. The selected text is highlighted in orange.

Cut/Copy the Text

- 1. Tap and hold the selected text.
- 2. Tap **Cut** or **Copy** in the menu that opens.
 - If you tap **Cut**, the selected text is removed from the text field. In this case, the text is saved to the clipboard so you can paste it into another text field.

Paste the Text

- 1. Cut or copy the text to paste.
- 2. Tap the text field where you want to paste the text and move the cursor to your desired location.
 - You can paste text that you copied from one application into the text field in any other application.
- 3. Tap and hold, then select **Paste** in the pop-up menu.
 - The text is inserted after the cursor, and the text remains in the clipboard so that you can paste that same text into another location.

NOTE: When you type, the notification panel will have a **select input method** so you can set the input methods.

Glide Typing

The Google Keyboard lets you to slide your finger across the letters to spell the word.

To enable glide typing

- 1. Touch and hold the comma (,) > tap **Settings** > **Glide Typing**.
- 2. Touch **Enable Gesture Typing** to turn ON/OFF. Slide your finger from letter to letter to spell a word.
- Do not lift your finger until you have completed spelling a word.

Google Voice Typing

Use voice recognition to convert speech to text. You must be connected to mobile data or Wi-Fi.

To enable Google voice typing

- 1. Tap \P on the Google search bar.
- 2. When "Try saying something" appears, speak your text.
- 3. Tap Ψ to end recording.

Adding, Editing or Deleting Words in the User Dictionary

Sometimes you may need to add a word to the predictive text dictionary, for example, a name or a specialised technical word. If you want to add a word to your User dictionary while entering text, double-tap or tap and hold to select the word, then select replace and tap **ADD TO DICTIONARY**.

Adding a word manually

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > tap the Settings 2 > System.
- 2. Tap Language & input > Personal dictionary.
- 3. Tap the plus sign and type the word and the shortcut.
- 4. Hit the < button on the keyboard to save.

Editing or deleting a word

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > tap the Settings [2].
- 2. Tap Language & input > Personal dictionary.
- 3. Type the word to delete or edit.
- 4. Tap the trash can to delete the word or 📀 to save the edit.

Selecting Text

You can select, copy or cut the text you've entered, then paste it in another text field within the user interface.

NOTE: Some applications may offer different text editing methods.

Selecting text

- 1. Tap the text field.
- 2. Move the cursor to the beginning or end of the desired text by tapping in the location you want the cursor.
- 3. Tap and hold the text field.
- 4. Tap **Select word** in the pop-up menu or tap **Select all** to select all the text in the text field.
- 5. Drag your finger to move the text cursor to the letter within the text that you want to select.

Cutting and Copying the Text

- 1. Tap and hold and use the blue icons to cut or copy it.
- 2. Tap Cut or Copy in the menu that opens.
 - If you tap **Cut**, the selected text is removed from the text field. In this case, the text is saved to the clipboard so that you can paste it into another text field.

Pasting the Text

- 1. Cut or copy the text to paste.
- 2. Tap the text field where you want to paste the text and move the cursor to your desired location.
 - You can paste text that you copied from one application into the text field in any other application.
- 3. Tap and hold, then select **Paste** in the pop-up menu.
 - The text is inserted after the cursor, and the text remains in the clipboard so that you can paste that same text into another location.

Screen Timeout/Sleep Mode ON

Sleep mode saves battery power by turning OFF your display. You will still receive messages and calls when the display is turned off.

Turning the Display OFF

• Press Power/Lock to turn your Orbic TAB8 4G display OFF.

To customise the screen timeout settings,

 From the Home screen, swipe up from the bottom of the screen to reveal all your Apps > Settings 2 > Display > Screen timeout.

Waking up your Orbic TAB8 4G

- 1. Your Orbic TAB8 4G automatically wakes up when you have an incoming call.
- 2. To wake it up manually, press **Power/Lock**.

Unlocking the screen

• Swipe up on the **Lock** screen to unlock the Orbic TAB8 4G.

NOTE: If you have set up a screen unlock pattern, pin, or password, you will be asked to draw the pattern on the screen or enter the PIN or password to access the Orbic TAB8 4G.

Configuring the Screen Lock

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > then find and tap Settings 2 Security > Screen lock.
 - If you have already configured the screen lock, tap **Screen lock** to change.
- 2. Tap Pattern, PIN, or Password.
- 3. Enter the custom pattern, PIN, or password as prompted.

Adjusting Volume

Ringtone and Media volume is independent of each other and adjusted separately.

Adjusting the Ringer Volume

From the Home screen, press **Volume up** or **Volume down** on the right side of the Orbic TAB8 4G to -

- Adjust the ringer volume to your desired level.
- While in the lowest ringer volume level, press **Volume down** once to set your Orbic TAB8 4G to **Silent** mode.
- While in the Silent, press **Volume up** once to switch to **ringtone mode**.

Adjusting the Media Volume

While playing music, watching a video or using preloaded or downloaded games or applications, press **Volume up** or **Volume down** on the right side of the Orbic TAB8 4G to adjust the media volume.

Adjusting the Earpiece Volume for Calls

During a call, press Volume up or Volume down.

Adjusting the volume via Settings menu

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > tap Settings 2.
- 2. Tap Sound.
- 3. Drag the volume sliders left or right to adjust your Orbic TAB8 4G's Media, Call, Ring & notification, and Alarm.
- 4. Your Orbic TAB8 4G plays a sample tone at the selected volume level while you drag the slider.

Connect Orbic TAB8 4G to the Computer

You can copy your music, photos, and other files to the microSD card of your Orbic TAB8 4G.

NOTE: This option is available only when a microSD card is inserted into the slot of your Orbic TAB8 4G. While your Orbic TAB8 4G is connected to a computer, **File transfer** mode prevents you from using applications that access the memory card.

- 1. Connect your Orbic TAB8 4G to your computer using the supplied USB cable.
- 2. Open the Notifications panel > tap **USB options**.
- 3. The connected Orbic TAB8 4G is recognised as a removable hard drive on your computer and select **File transfer**.
- 4. On your computer, navigate to the removable drive, and open it.
- 5. Choose the files from the Orbic TAB8 4G memory (Internal storage) or the microSD card.
- 6. After copying the files, unmount the removable drive (that is, your Orbic TAB8 4G) as required by your computer's operating system to remove your Orbic TAB8 4G safely.
- 7. After unmounting the removable drive, you can disconnect the Orbic TAB8 4G from the computer.

Calling


Making Calls

The simplest way to make a call is to dial the number directly. You can also call numbers listed in your Call log or Contacts list.

Making a call from the dialer screen

- From the Home screen, tap \$\screwt_s\$ or swipe up to reveal all your Apps, find and tap \$\screwt_s\$.
- 2. Tap 🕛 > and then the number you want to dial.
 - If you make a mistake, tap ≤ to erase a single character. > tap and hold ≤ to erase the entire string.
- 3. Tap 🕓 .
 - The Calling screen displays <u></u> in the Status bar while the call is active.
 - To change the volume during a call, press Volume Up / Volume Down.
- 4. Tap 📀 to end the call.

NOTE: Your Orbic TAB8 4G supports Speaker phone mode, Headphone calls, or calls over Bluetooth only. It is not designed to be held up at the ear.



Making an International Call

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 🐛 .
- 2. Tap and hold **0** until the international prefix '+' appears.
- 3. Tap the country code, area code, and phone number.
- 4. Tap 🕓 .

Making a Call from the Contact list

- From the Home screen, tap < > Contacts
 or swipe up to reveal all your Apps > Contacts
- 2. Scroll through the contact list.
 - To find a specific contact, you can search by tapping
 Search. Enter the name of the contact you're searching for. As you type, contacts with matching names appear below the search box. Or you can use the TAB on the right side of the screen to scroll through the alphabetical contacts.
- 3. Tap the contact you want to call > Tap 📞 Call.

Making an Emergency Call

Your Orbic TAB8 4G supports Emergency Calling. You can call emergency services on your Orbic TAB8 4G when you see or have an emergency.

Emergency call service may not be available on all the mobile service providers. If you are unsure, please check with your local service providers.

Emergency service numbers are -

- International: 112
- United States: 911
- UK: 999
- Germany: 110
- · Japan (Ambulance & Fire): 110
- Japan (Police): 119
- Australia: 000
- New Zealand: 111

NOTE: Some locations do not charge for emergency calls, so please check with your local service provider.

To make an emergency call

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 🐛 .
- 2. Enter your local emergency number.
- 3. Tap 🕓 to place the call.
- 4. Tap 📀 to end the emergency call.

To make an emergency call when the Orbic TAB8 4G is locked

When your Orbic TAB8 4G has no service status, the **Emergency** call button is displayed on the lock screen.

- 1. Tap Emergency call.
- 2. Enter your local emergency number.
- 3. Tap 🕓 to place the call.
- 4. Tap 📀 to end the call.

Answering or Declining an Incoming Call

You can either answer or decline a call from the notification of the incoming call that displays on the home screen.

To answer or decline a call

- 1. Press **DECLINE** to reject the call or press **ANSWER** to answer the call.
 - If you are already on a call, the first call is placed on hold when answering the new call.
 - To silence the ringer before answering the call, press the volume keys.



Checking Missed Calls

- If you miss a call, 🔀 is displayed in the Status bar.
- If you open the Notifications panel, you will see the number of missed calls. Tap the notification to be taken to the call log and view detailed information.

Using In-Call Options

When a call is in progress, the following options are available:

Dial Pad	Tap Dial Pad to enter additional numbers during your call.
Mute	You can unmute the microphone by tapping Mute icon again.
Add call	Tap Add call to put the current call on hold and add another person to the call.
Bluetooth	When a Bluetooth device is paired and connected to your Orbic TAB8 4G, you can conduct all calls using Bluetooth for hands-free conversation. When using Bluetooth headset during a call, the current call screen has a blue border and the Ongoing Call icon turns blue in the Status bar.
	Tap Bluetooth icon to toggle in-call audio to and from the Bluetooth accessory.

NOTE: To avoid damaging your hearing, do not hold the Orbic TAB8 4G up to your ear when the speaker mode is ON.


Using the Call History Menu

The Orbic TAB8 4G stores the numbers of all incoming and outgoing calls in the Call log. The call history displays the details of the call including time, date, and duration.

Opening the Call History Menu

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 📞 > 🕓 Call history.
- Calls are listed with the most recent at the top. Calls of the same phone number are grouped together. Scroll to view earlier entries in the log.

NOTE: You can tap and hold the desired number in the call log list to select options such as **Copy number, Edit number before call, Block number, Delete.**



Calling a number from the Call history

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 📞 > 🕓 Call history.
- 2. If you want to call a number directly, tap $\$ to the right of the entry or select a contact > tap \odot to place the call.
 - If you want to edit a number before calling, tap and hold the desired entry, and then tap Edit number before call.

Adding a phone number from your Call history

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 📞 > 🕓 Call history.
- 2. Tap the desired entry > Add to contacts.
- 3. In the list of contacts that opens, tap **Create new contact** or add to an existing contact.
- 4. Tap Done.

Sending a text message from Call history

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 📞 > 🕓 Call history.
- 2. Tap the contact > **Send text message**.
- 3. Enter your message and tap > to send the message.

Clearing the Call log

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 📞 > 🕓 Call history.
- 2. Tap Option > Call History > Tap Option > Clear call history > OK.
 - To remove just one entry from the Call history menu, touch and hold the entry. In the pop-up options, tap Delete > OK.

Listening to Your Voicemail

Voicemail application is displayed only when the calls are available. When you have a new voicemail message, **OO** appears in the Status bar.

Calling your voicemail from the Dial Pad

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 🐛 .
- 2. Enter your voicemail number and 🕓 .

Calling your voicemail from the Notification panel

NOTE: The voicemail number usually is preprogrammed to speed dial 1.

- 1. Open the Notifications panel.
- 2. Tap and hold the number **1** key on the dial pad to initiate a call to voicemail.

Messaging

You can send and view messages by conversation.

To access message

• From the Home screen, tap to open the message screen.

Sending a Message

- 1. Launch the message app and tap 🗉 Start chat
- 2. Add recipients in the **To** field.
- 3. Type your message in the text message field.
 - To record and send a voice message, tap and hold say your message, and then release your finger. The recording icon appears only while the message input field is empty.
 - To include an attachment in the message, tap \oplus .
- 4. Tap > to send the message.

Replying/Forwarding a Message

- 1. Launch the message app and select the message that you want to reply or forward.
- 2. Edit the message, if required.
- 3. Tap > to send the message.

Deleting a Message/Thread

- 1. On the message screen, touch and hold the message or the message thread that you want to delete.
- 2. Tap 🔟 to delete the message.
- 3. Confirm the prompt to delete the selected message/thread.

Message Settings

- 1. On the message screen, tap and tap **Settings** 🔯.
- 2. You can block unwanted messages, change notification settings, and much more.

Email

Use the Gmail app to view and manage your email accounts. You can add multiple email accounts to your Orbic TAB8 4G.

To access the email account

Tap Home key ● > Google folder > Gmail M .

Adding an Account

- 1. Launch Settings > Passwords & accounts.
- 2. Tap + Add account.
- 3. Enter the email address and password.
- 4. Follow the prompts to set up your email account.

Removing an Account

- 1. Select the account that you want to remove.
- 2. Tap Remove Account.
- 3. Confirm the prompt to remove the account or **Cancel** to retain the account.

Composing an Email

- From the Home screen > tap Google > Gmail M.
- 2. Tap + to compose a new email.
- 3. Tap the **To** field to add an email address manually or tap to select a recipient from Contacts.
 - If entering the recipients manually, enter additional recipients by separating each with a semicolon (;).
- 4. Enter the subject for the email and compose the message.

- Tap to insert an attachment (Files, Images, Audio, and much more), if required.
- Review your message and tap > to send the composed email.

Responding to an Email

- From the Home screen > tap Google > Gmail M.
- 2. Select the email from your inbox to read.
 - Tap **h** to reply to the sender.
 - Tap > Forward to forward the email to another person.
 - Tap > tap Forward to forward the email to another person.
- 3. Compose your message and tap to send.

Switching Between Google Accounts

If you have set up two or more Google Accounts on your Orbic TAB8 4G, you can switch between them in **Gmail**. Gmail displays only one Google Account at a time. The current account is shown at the top right of any message list.

- From the Home screen, swipe up to reveal all your Apps > then find and tap on Gmail M .

These settings allow you to customise your email settings.

Capturing a Photo

You can manually adjust ISO, shutter speed, and exposure levels, add filters and adjust the white balance settings to accommodate different lighting conditions.

To access ProMode,

- 2. Tap on the available Camera settings and adjust to suit your preferences.
 - **Exposure** The Exposure compensation is easy to identify because of its + and symbols. Manual modes will often do this automatically, but it is a setting you can adjust yourself. Even if you have set the exposure to where you want it to, this setting can tweak to a little lighter or darker.
 - Aperture & Shutter Speed You can adjust the shutter speed. A slow shutter speed lets in more light, resulting in brighter photos or videos. It is ideal for nighttime or scenery photos or videos. Fast shutter speeds allow less light to enter. This is ideal for capturing photos or videos of fast-moving subjects.

- White Balance The white balance adjusts the colour temperature. The blue end of the spectrum is the cold end. Orange, or warm, is on the other end of the spectrum. This can be adjusted while taking a photo to make it look more realistic.
- **ISO** An ISO value determines the camera's sensitivity to light. It is ideal to use low values for brightly lit or stationary subjects. Poorly lit or fast-moving subjects benefit from high values.



Calendar

Use the calendar app to manage your tasks and events.

To access Calendar

• Tap the Home key ● > swipe up for Apps > Calendar 🛐 .

Creating an Event

- 1. Launch Calendar > tap + to add a new event.
- 2. Enter the details for the event.

Bluetooth

- Data warning & limit You can customise data warnings and limitations from the mobile network.
- **Preferred network type** Choose the desired network.
- Wi-Fi calling Choose calling preferences.
- Access Point Names Choose or add APNs, which
 have the network settings your Orbic TAB8 4G needs
 to connect to.

Aeroplane mode

The Aeroplane mode turns OFF the Wi-Fi and Bluetooth and disconnects your Orbic TAB8 4G from all networks.

When you are in Aeroplane mode, you can use other features such as playing music, watching videos, and using offline applications.

- Colour correction Adjust the screen colour if you have colour-blindness or difficulty in reading the screen display.
- **Colour inversion** Reverse the display of colours.
- **Remove animations** Remove specific screen effects if you are sensitive to motion.
- Large mouse cursor Use large pointer for a connected mouse.
- **High-contrast text** Adjust the colour and outline of the text to increase the contrast with the background.
- 5. Tap **Extra dim** to dim the screen beyond the minimum brightness setting for more comfortable viewing.
- 6. Tap **Dark theme** to enable black background to help keep the battery alive longer on some screens.
- 7. Tap **Magnification** to magnify the content shown on the screen.
- 8. Tap **Accessibility menu** to customise additional accessibility features and services for your Orbic TAB8 4G.
- 9. Tap **Switch access** to control the Orbic TAB8 4G with customised switches.
- 10. Tap **Caption preferences** to configure closed caption and subtitle services.

Security

Using a screen lock, you can secure your Orbic TAB8 4G and protect your data. With this option enabled, you can use your finger to draw a pattern or enter a PIN to unlock your device's screen.

To access security

Google Play Protect

Google Play protects and monitors your apps and Orbic TAB8 4G for harmful behavior. It also warns you from potentially dangerous apps.

To run the scan

- 1. Tap Security > Google Play protect.

Find My Device

Find My Device helps you locate this Orbic TAB8 4G remotely. It also lets you to keep your data secure if you lose this Orbic TAB8 4G.

To use Find My Device

 - **Password**: Create a password for unlocking the screen.

NOTE: If you forget your pattern, PIN, or password, you will have to reset your Orbic TAB8 4G to factory settings, which will remove all data from your Orbic TAB8 4G.

Smart lock

Encryption and credentials

You can manage the trusted security certificates installed on your Orbic TAB8 4G, which verify the identity of servers for secure connections.

- Install a certificate
- Clear credentials

App pinning

You can use app pinning to keep one app in view, preventing users from switching to other apps and accessing your personal information.

To pin an app

- 1. Tap Security > App pinning.
- 2. Tap Use app pinning to enable the feature.

Privacy

You can use these options to configure advanced security settings to protect your Orbic TAB8 4G better.

To access privacy

Tap Settings 2 > Privacy.

Permission Manager

Apps might access features of your Orbic TAB8 4G that you permit them to when running in the background, not just when you are using the app.

- 1. Tap Privacy > Permission Manager.
- 2. Tap a category and tap an app to select which permissions you want to be notified about.

Show passwords

You can have characters displayed briefly in password fields as you type them.

• Tap **Privacy** and tap **Show passwords** to turn on the feature.

Location

Location services use a combination of GPS, mobile network, and Wi-Fi to determine the location of your Orbic TAB8 4G.

To access the location

- 1. Tap the **Home key** > swipe up for **Apps** > **Settings** ◎ > **Location.**
- 2. Tap Use location to turn on the spot.

App location permissions

You can configure permissions for apps that want to access your location information.

- 1. Tap Location > App location permissions.
- 2. Tap an app and choose which location permissions to grant.

Location services

Location services store and use your Orbic TAB8 4G's most recent location data. Certain apps can use this data to improve your search results based on your visited places.

- 1. Tap Location > Location services.
- 2. Tap an entry under Location services to see how your location information is used.

Safety & emergency

You can set up emergency SOS information.

To access Safety & emergency

- Tap the Home key > swipe up for Apps > Settings @ > Safety & emergency.
- 2. Tap **Emergency information** to enter your medical information and the number to contact during any

emergency.

- 3. Tap Emergency SOS to set up the SOS feature.
 - Tap Use Emergency SOS to enable the feature. Once the SOS feature is enabled, tapping the Power button five times in a row will call the emergency services or your chosen contact.
 - Tap Play countdown alarm, If you wish your Orbic TAB8 4G to play an alarm when your Emergency SOS is activated.

To add an account

- 2. Tap one of the account types.
- 3. Follow the prompts to enter your credentials and set up the account.
- 4. Tap Automatically sync app data to enable automatic updates to your accounts.

Digital Wellbeing & parental controls

Monitor and manage your digital habits by getting a daily view of how often you use apps, how many notifications you receive, and how often you check your Orbic TAB8 4G. You can also set your Orbic TAB8 4G so that it helps you relax before you sleep.

Check on your kids

Parental Controls - You can monitor your children's digital life with Google's Family Link app. The app can be downloaded from the Play Store

 You can set the content filters, watch screen time, and set screen time limits.

To access the system

Languages and input

Configure your Orbic TAB8 4G's language and input settings.

- 1. Tap System > Languages and input > Languages.
- 2. Select the desired language from the list to set it as default.
- 3. Tap the **On-screen keyboard** under **Keyboards** > select the desired keyboard from the list.
- 4. Tap **Spell checker** under **Tools** to enable the spell-checking feature.
- 5. Tap **Personal dictionary** under **Tools** to add new words to apps such as Spell checker.
- 6. Tap **Pointer speed** under **Tools** to set the speed of the pointer.

System Update

Software updates are automatically sent to your Orbic TAB8 4G. You will receive an alert whenever a new update is available.

NOTE:

- Back up all your information before a software update.
- Make sure the Orbic TAB8 4G is powered ON with a fully charged battery.
- Never turn OFF the Orbic TAB8 4G during the software update.
- During the updating period, the Orbic TAB8 4G will reboot twice. Do not operate the Orbic TAB8 4G until the update is complete.

COVID-19 Exposure Notification

This notification feature helps you to understand whether you have been exposed to someone who reports having COVID-19.

To get notified, you need to either download an official app from your region's government public health authority or, if supported in your region, enable it directly in your device **Settings**.

- If you have COVID-19, you may share that info in **Exposure Notifications** to help alert the people you have been in contact with.
- If you have been exposed to someone who has shared they have COVID-19, you may be notified and provided with further instructions.

Do not operate the Orbic TAB8 4G in an environment that might be susceptible to radio interference resulting in danger.

Specific Absorption Rate (SAR) Safety

This Orbic TAB8 4G has been designed to comply with applicable safety requirements for exposure to radio waves. These requirements are designed for the safety of all persons and follow scientific guidelines including safety margins.

- The radio wave exposure guidelines employ a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate or SAR. Tests for SAR are conducted using standardised methods, with the Orbic TAB8 4G transmitting at its highest certified power level in all used frequency bands.
- Orbic TAB8 4G is designed and manufactured not to exceed emission limits for radio frequency (RF) energy exposure.
- This Orbic TAB8 4G is in compliance with the Specific Absorption Rate (SAR) for the general population or uncontrolled exposure limits (2.0W/kg and 4.0W/kg) specified in Council Recommendation 1999/519/EC and had been tested in accordance with the measurement methods and procedures specified in EN 62209-1:2016 and EN 62209-2:2010+AMD1:2019.
- The highest SAR value for this model tested for use when worn on the body is 1.285W/kg (10g).
- Orbic TAB8 4G meets RF exposure guidelines when used in the normal position at least 0 mm away from the body.

When a carry case, belt clip, or holder is used for body-worn operation, it should not contain metal and should position the product at least 5 mm away from your body.

Battery Use

Handle and store batteries properly to avoid injury or damage. Most battery issues arise from improper handling of removable batteries and, particularly, from the continued use of damaged batteries.

- Do not disassemble, open, crush, bend, deform, puncture, or shred.
- Do not modify or remanufacture, attempt to insert foreign objects into the battery, immerse or expose to water or other liquids, or expose to fire explosion or other hazards.

Troubleshooting

Here are a few things you can try before contacting the service center.

Your Orbic TAB8 4G displays network or service error.

You may lose reception in areas with weak signals or poor reception. Move to another location and try again.

Your Orbic TAB8 4G does not turn ON.

When the battery is completely discharged, your Orbic TAB8 4G will not turn ON. Charge the battery fully before turning on the Orbic TAB8 4G.

The touchscreen responds slowly or improperly.

- If you attach a screen protector or optional accessories to the touchscreen, it may not function properly.
- If you are wearing gloves, your hands are not clean while touching the touchscreen, or if you tap the screen with sharp objects or your fingertips, the touchscreen may malfunction.
- The touchscreen may malfunction in humid conditions or when exposed to water.
- Restart your Orbic TAB8 4G to clear any temporary software bugs.
- Ensure that your Orbic TAB8 4G has the latest version of the software.

Your Orbic TAB8 4G freezes or encounters a fatal error.

- 1. Restarting the Orbic TAB8 4G
 - If your Orbic TAB8 4G freezes or hangs, you may need to close apps or turn OFF the Orbic TAB8 4G and turn it ON again.
- 2. Forcing restart
 - Press and hold the **Power/Lock** key to restart your

Orbic TAB8 4G if it is frozen.

- 3. Resetting the Orbic TAB8 4G
 - If the methods above do not solve your problem, perform a factory data reset.

Calls are not connected.

- Ensure that you have accessed the right network.
- Ensure you have not set call barring for the phone number you dial.
- Ensure that you have not set call barring for the incoming phone number.

Your Orbic TAB8 4G cannot find your current location.

It is possible that GPS signals are obstructed in some locations, such as inside buildings. Set the Orbic TAB8 4G to use Wi-Fi or a mobile network to find your current location in these situations.
